Dear Parents and Guardians,

The Secret Harbour's Got Talent Concerts are informal concerts in normal Music classes to give students the opportunity to perform, something of their own choice, any musical/talent item they wish.

The class concerts will run in weeks 7 & 8 of this term with the best of the acts chosen to perform at the whole school concert in the last day of Term 3.

WHAT HAPPENS?

Who Performs? Every child is encouraged to participate but is run on volunteer basis so no one will be forced to perform. They can perform in groups or individually. (It's encouraged for the Groups be from within the same class.)

Number & Length of Items-

Children can be in two items at the most.



Types of Items- Items can be instrumental, singing, dancing, drama, circus, magic or poetry items, as long as they use music is involved. Lyrics of songs must be rate G.

Equipment- Students may use the instruments and equipment in the Music Room.

CDs, Ipods & Youtube - CDs are the easiest and safest to use.

Please ensure names are in the CD covers. Ipods are not a good idea because they can be lost, broken or stolen and the school **cannot** replace them. Youtube is an option but if advised beforehand. If I am not familiar with the video clip that your child asks for I will play the lyric's video clip of their song. (This is to ensure the clip is suitable for the class.)



Dressing Up- Performers may dress up for their concert but they need to wear normal uniform for the remainder of the day. No make up please.

Items To Be Written On Program Sheets - Items need to be written on the program sheets displayed in their classrooms.



Planning & Practise- Students need to practise in their own time due to the large number of children involved.

Parents Welcome- You are welcome to attend your child's class concert. Please check when their music lessons are on and check in at the office, on arrival, for a visitor's badge.

These concerts are a great opportunity for your child/ren to have fun performing in front of their class.
