This year we will be continuing to support the integration of The Arts and Health & Physical Education in the Australian Curriculum with students participating dance-based activities to explore, represent, respond to and interpret ideas and to develop skills and processes to enable them to develop an understanding of the world around them and its different cultures in a safe environment. Dance is also key to combining and further developing fundamental movement skills that develop body awareness, coordination, control, balance and strength.

During Term 4 students from Years 5 and 6 will be participating in our DanceSport incursion. This program will run for 5 weeks in addition to their normal phys ed lesson time and has been developed to enhance student learning in The Arts and HPE curriculum and it is highly recommended that all students participate. DanceSport will also be a part of the Year 6 Graduation Lunch at the end of Term 4.
